YOUR HOME

We know it can be challenging to omit or reduce single-use plastic in the home.

It's there when you shop, it's there in online packaging, it's even in things you might not expect it to be.

But, with a little effort and 100% commitment, you can play a part in preventing plastic pollution in the River Tamar, its tributaries and out into the ocean - keeping the water where your live clean and healthy for all who depend on it.

Our Preventing Plastic Pollution team collected more than 1,200 pieces of food-related single-use plastic from urban and rural river locations in just seven litter picks in 2020.

We want to reduce that to **ZERO**.

Read on to see what you can do to help.

THINGS TO TRY

Making small changes at home can make a positive difference - why not try:

- Swapping plastic packaged toiletries for alternatives such as soap or shampoo bars
- Choosing loose leaf for your tea
- Ditching the coffee pods and using filters or even instant
- Discovering your local refill shops typing 'refill' in an internet map search can show locations
- Avoiding the purchase of clothing made from plastic-based materials such as woven polyester - they shed microplastics in the wash
- Following the 3Ps pee, poo, and paper should be the only things flushed down the loo.

Think of rivers as the veins of the Earth. By keeping them clean and free-flowing, they will sustain us with the vital natural resource we depend on, water.
